General Nuttall retired from the Army in 2011 with nearly 40 years of service. He commanded Army tactical formations as the Battery, Battalion, and Brigade levels. His final assignment was as the Deputy Commanding General of the First United States Army where he was responsible for training, readiness, and mobilization of Reserve Component soldiers in support Army force generation plans worldwide.

From 2006 to 2009, General Nuttall served as the Deputy Director of the Army National Guard. In this role he was responsible for the manning, organizing, equipping, sustaining, training and missioning of over 350,000 soldiers and a supervising a budget of more than \$14.5B annually. He provided policy and guidance to the staffs of 54 states and territories.

From 2004 to 2006, General Nuttall was the Deputy Director, Operations, Readiness, and Mobilization, Department of the Army where he was responsible for all Title 10 functions associated with Army Current Operations. He directed the Army support effort for Hurricane's Katrina and Rita.

During his distinguished military career, General Nuttall served on numerous enlisted and officer promotion boards as well as command selection boards at the Company through Brigade levels.

General Nuttall received a bachelor's degree in business administration from the Roger Williams University. He also holds a master's degree in international relations from Salve Regina University. His military schools include the United States Army War College and the National Defense University's CAPSTONE course.
